SUBJECT: ASSOCIATION OF ADMINISTRATORS OF THE INTERSTATE COMPACT ON THE PLACEMENT OF CHILDREN (AAICPC) 36TH ANNUAL CONFERENCE

The purpose for this All County Information Notice (ACIN) is to inform counties of the 36th Annual AAICPC Conference that will be held in Atlanta, Georgia, from April 16 – 20, 2010.

The California Department of Social Services would like to strongly encourage all interested county staff to participate in this event. The conference provides an opportunity for all member states to receive training on the Interstate Compact on the Placement of Children (ICPC), and to share information and best practices regarding interstate placements and the current compact. Additionally, at this year's conference it is anticipated that there will be a vote on the newly proposed Regulation 11 regarding supervision and reporting of ICPC cases, as well as potential changes being considered to current ICPC Regulations (regulations 1, 3, and 7). As a result, decisions made at this year's meeting could impact the responsibilities of counties with respect to ICPC placements.

This conference is a wonderful opportunity to network with, and learn from, the compact liaisons of other states. Whether your ICPC liaison is relatively new to their job or has years of experience working with ICPC, the information provided will play a vital role in helping them to ensure positive outcomes for children placed across state lines.
