The California Department of Social Services (CDSS) has received numerous questions regarding the Hague Convention on International Adoption requirements for emigrating children, children who are being placed for adoption outside of the United States (U.S.). While Family Code section 8924 addresses emigrating children, CDSS would like to direct you to more detailed resources outlining the requirements for emigrating children.
