SUBJECT: DISASTER GUIDANCE ATTACHMENT- DISASTER SUPPLEMENTAL NUTRITION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM/DISASTER CALFRESH INCOME ELIGIBILITY STANDARDS AND ALLOTMENTS EFFECTIVE OCTOBER 1, 2011

This letter is to inform counties that the United States Department of Agriculture, Food and Nutrition Service (FNS) has issued a new Disaster Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (D-SNAP) Income Eligibility Standards and Allotments Attachment effective October 1, 2011.

Effective October 1, 2011, the D-SNAP net monthly income eligibility levels are increasing for all household sizes. The maximum shelter deduction will increase from \$458 to \$459 for a one person household. The standard deduction amount for household sizes of one, two, and three will increase from \$142 to \$147 a month. The disaster gross income limits are computed by adding these components and will therefore increase for all household sizes. The allotment amounts remain unchanged for federal fiscal year (FFY) 2012.

Below is an example of this computation: To obtain the Disaster Gross Income Limit for a one person household, add the following:

Maximum Monthly Net Income Limit for household size of one (100% of FPL)	+\$908
Maximum Standard Income	+\$147
Deduction Maximum Shelter Expense	
Deduction	+\$459
Disaster Gross Income Limit	=\$1514
