SUBJECT: FOOD STAMP PROGRAM - STANDARD UTILITY UPDATE

As a result of a utility survey conducted by the Food Stamp Systems Bureau, a new state standard utility allowance of \$74 will be promulgated in state regulations effective October 1, 1979 to reflect a seasonal and rate adjustment in utility costs.

Counties will have until December 31, 1979 to convert their entire caseload to the new utility standard. Counties may begin processing cases immediately for October 1 implementation. During the three-month conversion period, the new standard should be used for all new applications and for all recertifications and recomputations within a certification period. When a household reports a change, the case should be updated to reflect the new standard regardless of whether the reported change requires a budget recomputation. For example, when a household reports a change of address the Eligibility Worker would make the address change in the casefile and also update the utility standard to reflect the new \$74 amount. If possible, the current worksheet may be used to document the conversion to the new standard.

The implementation of the new standard constitutes a mass change under Manual Section 63-504.341. The change to the new standard shall not be considered a switch from the actual amounts to the standard for purposes of Section 63-502.353.
