The Tile XX Social Services Worker Time Survey for the January-March 1979 report quarter is being rescheduled for Thursday, February 22, 1979. The earlier notice announced the time survey for 1/17/79.

Counties were notified on January 12, 1979 by telephone of the change of survey date. The change was necessary due to the unexpected depletion of the SOC 241 forms needed to complete the survey.
