Pursuant to the stipulated judgment in the case of <u>Gardner v. Woods</u> this notice is to emphasize the importance of considering the application of the income proration method provided for in EAS 44-102b during the AFDC intake process.

Although the relevance of this regulation may not always be apparent, it must not be overlooked when determining the eligibility of applicants from various occupational groups such as school district employees (e.g., teachers, teacher's aids, custodians, etc).
