ALL-COUNTY INFORMATION NOTICE I-118-81

TO: ALL COUNTY WELFARE DIRECTORS

SUBJECT: 1981 FOOD STAMP PROGRAM CHANGES

REFERENCE: ALL-COUNTY LETTER 81-98

The purpose of this letter is to provide additional and corrected information concerning the 1981 Food Stamp Program Changes as a follow-up to the referenced All-County Letter.

The following items are included in the package:

1. Caseload Conversion Checklist (Temp 1488), revised master.

The checklist contained in All-County Letter 81-98 contained two errors which have been corrected. The attached revision is designated as (10-81-1). The corrections are as follows:

- In the instructions for processing new applications, the date now correctly reads January 31, 1982. Please note that the corresponding paragraph under "Implementation" in the All-County Letter should also have read January 31, 1982.
- The table of Maximum Gross Monthly Income Eligibility Standards at the bottom of the checklist contained an error for a household size of seven. The gross monthly income for a household size of seven has been corrected to read \$1,364.

2. Attachment A, Food Stamp Program Regulation Changes, pages A-13 and A-14, Expedited Service, revised.

It has been determined that where expedited service is provided to a household applying after the fifteenth of the month and verification is postponed, a notice of adverse action is not required in the following circumstances:

- When postponed verification is completed and results in a change in eligibility or benefits.

- When postponed verification is not completed within 30 days of the date of application and program participation is terminated.

Pages A-13 and A-14 of Attachment A have been revised to reflect this change.

3. Form Instructions for the DFA 377.1, revised.

The form instructions contained in All-County Letter 81-98 have been revised to reflect the change described in number 2 above. The references to additional notification requirements when benefits or eligibility change, or when benefits are terminated, because of postponed verification, have been deleted.

4. Attachment B, Food Stamp Benefit Change Notice, Spanish Translation.

As indicated in All-County Letter 81-98, the required language for the mass change notice has been translated into Spanish. A master copy of the translation is attached for reproduction.

5. Table I, Maximum Gross Monthly Income Eligibility Standards.

The maximum standards for household sizes of 10 through 20 were incorrectly computed in the table contained in All-County Letter 81-98. The table has been revised to correctly reflect the maximum standards for these households.

6. Table II, Reciprocal Table for Prorating First-Month Benefits, revised.

The percentage for the thirteenth (13th) day of a 30-day month was incorrect in the table issued by All-County Letter 81-98. The table has been revised to reflect the correct percentage (.6) for this proration.

7. Tables of Coupon Issuance.

All-County Letter 81-98 stated that the current Tables of Coupon Issuance would remain in effect with the implementation of the 1981 program changes, and would next be revised in April 1982. Since the issuance of this letter, however, FNS determined that the tables needed to be revised as a result of the gross income eligibility provision.

The 1981 Omnibus Reconciliation Act states that each household is subject to either the gross income standard or the net income standard, but not both. As a result, some households which would not have received benefits under the July 1981 tables will receive benefits under the revised tables. There will, however, still be households which are gross-income eligible, but which are entitled to zero benefits. It is therefore important that the cover sheet to the Tables of Coupon Issuance be read carefully and adhered to when determining an eligible household's coupon allotment.

The revised Tables of Coupon Issuance are currently being processed for incorporation in the Food Stamp Program Handbook (Chapter 63-1100).

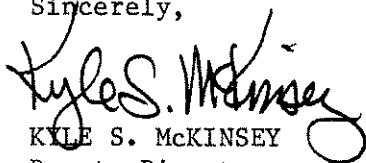
8. Draft Regulations.

A copy of the draft regulations for these changes is attached for your information. Processing of the regulations is proceeding on schedule.

Also for your information, processing of revised regulations concerning verification and aliens is proceeding on schedule with planned effective dates of December 1, 1981 and January 1, 1982, respectively. It is suggested that counties begin flagging cases which will be affected by these changes in order to simplify implementation.

EXPEDITED SERVICE

Description of Change

1. If a household is eligible for expedited service and verification is postponed, the following apply:
 - a. The certification period is (1) the month of application if the date of application is on or before the fifteenth of the month, or (2) the month of application and the subsequent month if the date of application is after the fifteenth of the month.
 - b. When a certification period is the month of application and the subsequent month, the household must be notified in writing at the time of certification that (1) the second month's benefits will not be issued until verification is completed, (2) participation will be terminated if verification is not completed 30 days from the date of application, and (3) advance notice will not be provided if the verification results in a change in eligibility or benefit level.
 - c. When a household applies after the fifteenth of the month, the second month's benefits are issued within five days from the date postponed verification is completed or the first of the second month, whichever is later.
2. When a household is provided expedited service, the first-month benefits are prorated from the date of application.
3. A notice of adverse action is not required when the completion of postponed verification results in a change in eligibility or benefits, or when participation is terminated due to failure to complete postponed verification within 30 days of the date of application.

Clarifications of Change

1. The verification requirements for expedited service have not changed.
2. The notice exemptions in Description of Change 3 apply only when the notice required in Description of Change 1b is provided.
3. Any household which is provided expedited service and which completes required verification prior to certification, may be assigned a normal certification period.

EXPEDITED SERVICE

Implementation

1. The above provision shall be applied beginning November 1, 1981, or at the county's option beginning October 1, 1981.
2. NA and PA cases (new applications).

When expedited service is provided and verification is postponed, provide the household with the DFA 377.1, Food Stamp Notice of Action, or the DFA 377.3, Food Stamp Notice of Approval/Food Stamp Notice of Expiration of Certification, with the required additional language (see revised form instructions).

NOTE: It is strongly recommended that the DFA 377.3 be used in this situation as it is more suited to the additional language requirements.

Form Instructions
(for Eligibility Worker)

Food Stamp Notice of Action and Right to Request a State Hearing

Purpose:

The DFA 377.1 is used by the Eligibility Worker to notify a household of the status of its food stamp case. It is used to notify households of:

- Approval actions;
- What additional information is needed for a pending case;
- Denial or termination actions;
- Changes in food stamp benefit amounts within the certification period; and,
- Reasons for the intended action(s) with the appropriate Food Stamp Manual Section.

This form may be used in certain circumstances instead of the old DFA 377.3 (Food Stamp Notice of Eligibility, Denial or Pending Status) and obsoletes the DFA 377.4 (Food Stamp Notice of Adverse Action).

- Note: (1) For short certification periods where a notice of expiration of certification is provided at the same time as a notice of approval, the DFA 377.3 Food Stamp Notice of Approval/Food Stamp Notice of Expiration of Certification may be provided instead of the DFA 377.1 and the DFA 377.2.
- (2) A change in circumstances which does not result in a change in food stamp benefits does not require a notice be provided. However, if the county chooses to provide a notice, the DFA 377.1 should be used.

The backside of the DFA 377.1 explains the household's right to request a hearing and provides instructions on how to appeal the intended action. The back also provides information needed by the household to continue aid pending a hearing if food stamp benefits are being reduced or terminated.

Note: The additional language concerning aid paid pending required by All-County Letter 81-28 and clarified by All-County Letter 81-38 must be used with this notice.

Preparation:

Complete an original and two copies of the DFA 377.1 entering the following identifying information:

*Revision to instructions issued by All-County Letter 81-98.

- Head of household's name and mailing address
- Case name
- Case number
- Worker number
- District (if applicable)
- Date

Complete the action portion of the notice by checking the heading box for each section used, and entering all other required information.

I. Approval

Check the Approval box when an application for food stamps has been approved. Enter the beginning and ending dates of the certification period, the amount of the allotment, and, if applicable, the amount and dates of a change in allotment.

If the household subsequently receives a cash grant, and food stamp benefits are reduced or terminated, an additional notice of action is not required.

Note: If the household applied after the fifteenth of the month, and if expedited service was provided and verification was postponed, the following language must be provided with the DFA 377.1:

Because you needed food stamp benefits right away, we postponed asking you to give us certain information. You now need to bring in or mail the following information before you can receive the rest of your food stamp benefits:

If the information you give us results in a change to your eligibility or benefits, you will not be notified before the change occurs. If you do not give us this information by _____, your participation in the Food Stamp Program will be terminated.

When using the above language, list the information that the household must provide and the date which is 30 days from the date of application.

II. Pending

Check the Pending box when further information is needed on a pending application for food stamps. Identify the information needed to complete the determination of eligibility and the date it must be received.

III. Denial/Termination

Check the Denial/Termination box when an application for food stamps is denied or benefits are terminated during the certification period. Check the appropriate box in the section for the action being taken and enter the reason for the intended action.

*Revision to instructions issued by All-County Letter 81-98.

IV. Change

Check the Change box when a change affects the food stamp benefit allotment. Check the appropriate box(es) in the section for the action being taken.

If the household fails to provide the information requested in this section and benefits are returned to the original allotment, an additional notice of action is not required.

Note: Current regulations do not provide for discontinuing benefits without a notice of action.

V. Other

Check the Other box and enter any information to be communicated to the household.

Manual Section

Circle the appropriate general Manual Section(s) for the above action(s) and enter the applicable specific Manual Sections.

Signature Block

Enter Eligibility Worker's name, telephone number and date.

Distribution:

The original and one copy are provided to the household. The second copy is filed in the case record.

AVISO DE CAMBIOS EN LOS BENEFICIOS DE
ESTAMPILLAS PARA COMIDA

Leyes federales aprobadas recientemente requieren varios cambios importantes en el Programa de Estampillas para Comida, los cuales entrarán en vigor a partir del 1o. de octubre de 1981. Estos cambios pueden afectar su elegibilidad y la cantidad de sus beneficios de estampillas para comida, pues definen de una manera nueva la elegibilidad de huéspedes, huelguistas, y el hogar que recibe estampillas para comida. Además, el cálculo basado en los ingresos netos usado anteriormente se ha reemplazado con cálculo basado en los ingresos brutos. Finalmente, se hará una reducción en la deducción de ingresos ganados. Su caso/solicitud será revisada y se podrán hacer cambios sin darle más aviso.

Si usted piensa que se ha calculado incorrectamente su elegibilidad o la cantidad de beneficios para estampillas para comida, tiene el derecho a pedir una audiencia con el estado. Su petición puede ser oral o por escrito, pero debe decir claramente que desea tener una audiencia y la razón para ella. La petición para una audiencia debe ser recibida en la Oficina del Jefe de Arbitros, Departamento de Servicios Sociales, 744 P Street, Sacramento, CA 95814, o por teléfono al (800) 952-5253 dentro de 90 días de la fecha de la acción con la cual usted está inconforme. Si usted pide una audiencia, la cantidad de sus beneficios de estampillas para comida actuales puede continuar hasta la fecha de la audiencia o hasta el final de su período de elegibilidad actual, la fecha que sea primera, únicamente si el asunto que esta apelando es que su elegibilidad o beneficios para estampillas para comida fueron calculados incorrectamente.

Usted puede pedir una audiencia por sí mismo, o puede pedirle ayuda a su trabajador(a) de elegibilidad. En la audiencia, usted tiene el derecho de que lo represente un abogado o cualquier otra persona que usted escoja. Puede obtener ayuda para localizar asistencia legal gratuita llamando al (800) 952-5253.

INFORMATION FOR COMPUTING FOOD STAMP ALLOTMENTS

July 1, 1981

48 States and the District of Columbia

To determine a household's food stamp coupon allotment using the Basis of Coupon Issuance Tables:

- 1) Calculate the household's net monthly income;
- 2) If the household does not contain any member who is sixty years of age or older, and does not contain any member who is disabled receiving SSI benefits or social security disability payments, eligibility has already been determined by the gross monthly income test. Find the allotment by reading in the table down to the appropriate income and across to the appropriate household size;
- 3) If the household contains a member who is sixty years of age or older, or is disabled receiving SSI benefits or social security disability payments, compare the household's net monthly income (A) to the maximum net monthly income standard for the appropriate household size (B).
 - If A is larger than B, the household is ineligible.
 - If B is larger than or equal to A, the household is eligible. Find the allotment by reading in the table down to the appropriate income and across to the appropriate household size.

To calculate the same figure manually (in lieu of using the tables):

- 1) Multiply the net monthly income by 30 percent;
- 2) Round the product down if it ends in 1 through 49 cents and up if it ends in 50 through 99 cents;
- 3) Subtract the result from the Thrifty Food Plan for the appropriate household size;
- 4) If the computation results in an allotment of \$1, \$3, or \$5, round up to \$2, \$4, or \$6, respectively;
- 5) If the allotment is for a one or two-person household and is less than \$10, round up to the minimum monthly allotment of \$10.

Use this formula to determine the coupon allotment if the household size is larger than twenty persons.

- ~~25~~.24 SSI recipients. No person receiving Supplemental Security Income/ State Supplementary Program (SSI/SSP) payments is eligible to receive food stamp benefits. Under the provisions of PL 95-458:
- 1) most California SSI/SSP recipients receive as part of their SSI/SSP benefit a cash amount in lieu of food stamp benefits;
 - 2) all SSI/SSP recipients in California are ineligible to receive food stamps. 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27.26 Disqualified individuals. Individuals disqualified for fraud, as set forth in Section 63.805.

28.27 Others. Other individuals who share living quarters with the household but who do not customarily purchase food and prepare meals with the household. For example, if the applicant household shares living quarters with another family to save on rent but does not purchase and prepare food together with that family, the members of the other family are not members of the applicant household.

Also, an individual or family which, because of a temporary loss of income, was forced to move into the home of friends or relatives. Under such circumstances, that person or family which customarily purchases food and prepares meals separately, from the household that took them in could apply as a separate household.

.91 A striker is defined as anyone involved in a strike or concerted stoppage of work by employees (including a stoppage by reason of the expiration of a collective-bargaining agreement) or any concerted interruption of operations by employees. Any employee affected by a lockout, however, is not deemed to be a striker.

An individual exempted from work registration by Section 63-407.2 on the date of application shall not be deemed a striker and shall be certified using normal eligibility and benefit level determination procedures.

.92 Households with striking members shall be ineligible to participate in the Food Stamp Program unless the household was eligible one day prior to involvement in the strike action and on the date of application.

The CWD shall perform two separate eligibility determinations.

a. Determine eligibility based on circumstances one day prior to the household member's involvement in the strike action. The CWD shall use the household's income as it stood one day prior to the member's involvement in strike action.

b. Determine eligibility under current circumstances. In determining the eligibility of the striker's household

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during strike action, the CWD shall use the household's income and other eligibility circumstances as it stood one day prior to the member's involvement in the strike adding any income anticipated by the household such as, but not limited to, income from the receipt of strike benefits or temporary employment during the strike. The household's regular monthly earned income attributable to the job on which the strike occurred would be deemed to remain the same during the strike as if the household member were still working.

.93 The household's income immediately prior to the involvement in the strike action at the date of application shall be verified at the time of application. Any anticipated income during the strike shall also be accounted for at this time. It is the responsibility of the household to provide the CWD with verification of such income for the purpose of determining eligibility and benefit levels in accordance with Section 63-300.5.

.94 The benefit level of an eligible striker's household is based on current circumstances; i.e., income from striker's benefits or any other nonstrike-related income, plus the monthly income which the striker was receiving at the time he/she became involved in the strike.

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.95 Strikers shall be subject to the work registration requirements
unless exempt under 63-407.2.

The SDSS shall provide the updated maximum net income standards which are to be implemented upon their effective date. Refer to Handbook Section 63-1101.5 for the most recent maximum net income standards and their effective dates.

The SDSS shall provide the updated standard deduction, excess medical costs, and maximum dependent care/excess shelter deduction, which are to be implemented upon their effective date. Refer to Handbook Section 63-1101 for the most recent standard deduction, excess medical

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costs, and maximum dependent care/excess shelter deduction and their effective dates. Deductions shall be allowed only for the following household expenses:

Amend Section 63-502.32 to read:

.32 Earned Income Deduction. ~~Twenty~~ eighteen percent of gross earned income as defined in Section 63-502.1. Earnings excluded in Section 63-502.2 shall not be included in gross earned income for purposes of computing the earned income deduction.

Amend Section 63-502.361 to read:

.361 The state utility standard, \$81, shall be used in calculating shelter costs of those households which incur certain utility costs separate and apart from their rent or mortgage payments. Each food stamp household which is entitled to the utility standard shall receive the total standard even if it shares the expenses with others. Households which do not incur any separate utility charges, or which are billed separately for only telephone costs, water, sewerage and garbage collection fees shall not be entitled to claim the standard utility allowance. Households not entitled to the standard utility allowance may claim actual utility expenses for any utility which it does pay separately. Verification of utility expenses shall be made in accordance with Section 63-300.513.

Roomers or boarders who do not incur certain utility costs (other than for telephone costs, water, sewerage and garbage collection fees) separate and apart from their rent ~~pay specified amount for~~

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~~rent and for utilities as part of the total monthly payment, shall
not receive the standard utility allowance. Treatment of such
shelter/utility expense is provided in Section 63-503.53.~~

~~.11 The eligibility and level of benefits for most households submitting an initial application shall be based on circumstances for the entire calendar month in which the household filed its application.~~

A household's eligibility shall be determined for the month of application by considering the household's circumstances for the entire month of application except for destitute households (see Section 63-503.4). However, county welfare departments may, with the prior approval of DSS and FNS, use a fiscal month if the CWD determines that it is more efficient and satisfies DSS that the accounting procedures fully comply with certification and issuance requirements contained in these regulations. A CWD may elect to use either a standard fiscal month for all households, such as from the 15th of one calendar month to the 15th of the next calendar month, or a fiscal month that will vary for each household depending on the date an individual files an application for the program.

A household's benefit level for the initial month of certification will be based on the day of the month it applies for benefits or the day the application is received in the appropriate office (see Section 63-300.31). Using a calendar or fiscal month, households shall receive benefits prorated from the day of application to

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the end of the month. Refer to Handbook Section 63-1101 for Reciprocal Table for computing first month benefits. As used in this subsection, the term initial month means either the first month for which an allotment is issued to a household, or the first month for which an allotment is issued to a household following any period of more than a month during which the household was not certified for participation in the Food Stamp Program.

After determining the allotment, the CWD shall round the product down if it ends in 1 through 49 cents and up if it ends in 50 through 99 cents. If the computation results in an allotment of \$1, \$3, or \$5, the allotment shall be rounded to \$2, \$4 or \$6, respectively. A household whose prorated allotment level is 49 cents or less would receive no allotment for the initial month.

Because of anticipated changes, a household may be eligible for the month of application, but ineligible in the subsequent month of application even if the processing of its application results in the benefits being issued in the subsequent month. Similarly, a household may be ineligible for the month of application, but eligible in the subsequent month due to anticipated changes in circumstances. Even though denied for the month of application, the household does not have to reapply in the subsequent month. The same application shall be used for the denial for the month of application and the determination of eligibility for subsequent months, within the timeliness standards in Section 63-301.1.

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Amend 63-503.13 as follows:

- .13 Eligibility and the level of benefits for recertifications shall be determined based on circumstances anticipated for the certification period starting the month following the expiration of the current certification period. If an application for recertification is ~~not received until after the current certification period has expired, the month of application shall be the month in which the application was filed as for any initial application~~ later than one month from the date the last certification period has expired, then that application shall be considered an initial application and benefits for that calendar or fiscal month will be prorated from the date of application as with any initial application.

Adopt 63-503.14 as follows:

- .14 Those households which are certified using expedited services procedures in 63-301.54, and which apply for benefits after the 15th of the month, shall be certified for the month of application and the subsequent month. Households that apply before the 15th of the calendar or fiscal month shall be certified for one month only. Benefits for the initial month shall be prorated from the day of application to the end of that fiscal or calendar month. However, the benefits for the month following the month of application shall not be issued until all necessary verification, not already provided, has been provided to the CWD. The CWD shall issue the second month's benefit not later than the 5th working

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day from the date the verification was provided by the household
or the first of the second month, whichever is later.

Amend 63-503.22 as follows:

.2 Determining Resources, Income and Deductions (Continued)

503.22 Determining Income. The counties shall determine food stamp
eligibility according to the household's gross income as defined
in Section 63-502.1. The eligibility worker, in determining the
household's eligibility, shall determine what sources are exempt
from consideration as income per Section 63-502.14. If an
applying household is destitute, the CWD shall compute its gross
income by counting only that income which the household receives
between the first day of the month and the date the household
applies. The household's gross nonexempt income shall then be
compared to the gross monthly income eligibility standards (see
Handbook Section 63-1101.5) for the appropriate household size
for final determination of eligibility. For households with a
member 60 or older or who receives Disability and Blindness
payments under Title II of the SSA Act refer to Section 63-503.322.

Amend Section 63-503.32 as follows:

.321 Gross monthly income as determined by Section 63-502.1 shall be compared to the gross monthly income eligibility standards for the appropriate household size to determine eligibility for the month. See Handbook Section 63-1101.6 for table.

.322 To determine eligibility of households with a member 60 years of age or older, or a member who receives Disability and Blindness payments under Title II of the SSA Act, the household's net income as determined by Section 63-503.312 shall be compared to

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the net monthly income eligibility standards for the appropriate household size to determine eligibility for the month. See Handbook Section 63-1101.5 for table.

.323 For households considered destitute in accordance with Section 63-503.4 eligibility shall be determined by computing its gross and net income as defined in Sections 63-502.1 and 63-503.31, comparing as appropriate, either the gross or net income to the corresponding income eligibility standards. See Handbook Section 63-1101.5 and .6 for table.

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~~.323~~.324 The household's monthly allotment shall be determined from the Coupon Allotment Tables on the basis of household size and net income. The counties shall issue food stamp coupons pursuant to the coupon allotment tables as promulgated and updated by the USDA. The SDSS shall provide the updated coupon allotment tables, which are to be implemented upon their effective date. Refer to Handbook Section 63-1101 for the most recent coupon allotment tables and their effective date.

.325 All eligible one and two-person households shall receive a minimum monthly allotment of \$10. In the initial month of application, these households shall receive a prorata share of the \$10, depending on the day on which they applied.

.326 It is possible for households with three or more members to be eligible for the program but have a net income which would set

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their benefit level at zero. When this occurs, the counties shall deny the household's application on the grounds that its net income exceeds the level at which benefits are issued.

.327 For an eligible household with three or more members which is entitled to benefits for the initial month but not the subsequent month, the CWD shall certify the household for the initial month only and terminate the case for the following month on the grounds that its net income exceeds the level at which benefits are issued.

.328 For those eligible households which are entitled to no benefits in their initial month of application in accordance 63-503.324, but are entitled to benefits in subsequent months, the CWD shall certify the households beginning with the month of application.

.329 When a household's circumstances change and it becomes entitled to a different income eligibility standard (move from gross income standard to net income eligibility standard), the CWD shall apply the different standard at the next recertification or whenever the CWD changes the household's eligibility, benefit level or certification period, whichever occurs first.

Amend 63-503.44 as follows:

.4 Destitute Households (Continued)

.44 Destitute households shall have their eligibility and level of benefits calculated for the month of application by considering

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only income which is received between the first of the month and the date of application. Any income from a new source that is anticipated more than ten days after the day of application shall be disregarded.

The benefit level for those households that apply after the 15th of the calendar or fiscal month and are certified under expedited procedures shall be calculated in accordance with Section 63-503.14.

.523 Deductible Expenses

The net income from self-employment minus the cost of doing business shall be added to other earned income and ¹⁸18 percent earned income deduction shall be applied to the total. Shelter costs the household actually incurs, even if the boarder contributes to the household for part of the household's shelter expenses, shall be computed to determine if the household will receive a shelter deduction. However, the shelter costs shall not include any shelter expenses paid directly by the boarder to a third party, such as to the landlord or utility company.

Repeal Section 63-503.53

.53 ~~Boarders as Households~~ (Section 63-503.53 has been repealed)

Boarders may be eligible as a food stamp household in their own right as long as they are not residents of a commercial boarding house. When determining the eligibility and benefit level of a boarder, THE CWD shall determine the boarder's shelter expenses by including any identifiable shelter expenses paid by the boarder. If a single payment is made for both room and board, the amount of the payment which exceeds the thrifty food plan for the number of persons in the boarder's household shall be considered a shelter expense. The roomer or boarder shall not receive the standard utility deduction unless such person actually pays certain utility

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~~expenses (see 63-502.351). The boarder receives no exclusion or deduction for the amount paid for board itself.~~

Amend Section 63-503.543 to read:

.543 Deductible Expenses

²⁰
The 18-percent earned income deduction shall apply to the prorated income earned by the disqualified member which is attributed to the household. That portion of the household's allowable shelter and dependent care expenses which are either paid by or billed to the disqualified member shall be divided evenly among the household members, including the disqualified member. All but the disqualified member's share is counted as a deductible shelter expense for the remaining household members. Proration of utility expenses applies only when actual amounts are claimed. The standard utility allowance shall not be prorated.

Certain changes are initiated by the State or Federal Government which may affect the entire caseload or significant portions of the caseload. The shelter/dependent care deductions; the thrifty food plan and standard deduction; annual and seasonal adjustments to the State's utility standard; periodic cost-of-living adjustments to Social Security, and other federal benefits; periodic adjustments to AFDC or GA payments; and other changes in the eligibility criteria based on legislative or regulatory actions.

63-1001 DEFINITION

Outreach consists of effective, comprehensive, ongoing efforts initiated and monitored by the state and performed with the cooperation and assistance of other public and private agencies, religious, business and civic groups, retail trade associations, unions, community organizations, new media, and other groups, organizations and associations to inform all low-income households potentially eligible to receive food stamps of the availability and benefits of the Food Stamp Program, and to ensure participation of eligible households that wish to participate by providing such households with reasonable and convenient access to the Program.

63-1002 COUNTY OUTREACH RESPONSIBILITIES

63-1002

- .1 The county shall designate an employee to serve as outreach coordinator for the county. This person will be responsible for liaison with state outreach staff or their contracted agents. The county outreach coordinator shall meet with state outreach staff or their contracted agents at least once monthly to discuss outreach projects which will impact the county and to discuss any problems brought forth by state outreach staff or their contracted agents with regard to measures to ensure participation.
- .2 The county shall submit the DFA 433 monthly report on Food Stamp Outreach, to the State Outreach Coordinator on a semiannual basis. The DFA 433 must

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be submitted on or before February 1 - to cover the period from July - December, and on or before August 1 - to cover the period from January - June.

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- .3 The county shall ask new applicants if they have been prescreened by the state-contracted agent. If applicants answer affirmatively, then the county shall ask them for the first three copies of the Form FSOP-1, Food Stamp Outreach Referral Form, that were given them by the state agent. If the applicant fails to submit the forms, the county shall not delay processing his or her application for this reason. If the applicant does submit the form, the county shall, upon completion of eligibility determination, record the disposition of the application by checking the appropriate box(es) in Part III (Status of the Application) of the "County Use Only" section, indicating whether application was approved, or denied and why denied, or withdrawn, cancelled, or that the applicant was already receiving food coupons. The county shall then hold one copy of each completed form for pickup on a monthly basis by the state-contracted agent. The second copy of each form shall be sent to the State Outreach Coordinator, DSS, on a monthly basis by the 10th of each month; however, if this procedure is unduly inconvenient for the county, both copies may be held for pickup by the contracted agent. Where the county has more than one state-contracted agent, each county district office shall provide the completed forms to the agent designated for the district. The third copy of the form is for county use.

- .4 County outreach coordinators shall provide state staff or their contracted

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~~agents with a listing of all county Food Stamp Certification offices,
including the addresses, days and hours of operation of such offices.
Updates to such listing shall be provided to state staff or their
contracted agents on a timely basis to ensure that current information
is being disseminated.~~

63-1000 PROGRAM INFORMATIONAL ACTIVITIES

63-1000

63-1001 DEFINITION

Program informational activities are those activities that convey information
about the Food Stamp Program, including household rights and responsibilities,
to applicant and recipient households through means such as publications,
telephone hotlines, films, media and face-to-face contacts.

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63-1002 COUNTY PROGRAM INFORMATIONAL ACTIVITIES

- .11 Informational materials regarding foods containing substantial amounts of the recommended daily allowances of protein, minerals, and vitamins; menus making use of these foods; and the relationship between health and diet;
- .12 Informational materials that explain the Special Supplemental Food Program for Women, Infants and Children (WIC) and the Commodity Supplemental Food Program (CSF);
- .13 Informational materials explaining household rights and responsibilities.
- .2 The county shall display the posters and make the pamphlets and fliers available at food stamp and public assistance offices.
- .3 All program informational material shall include a statement that the program is available to all without regard to race, color, sex, age, handicap, religious creed, national origin, or political beliefs.
- .4 The county shall notify the state of needs for program informational material in languages other than English as required by W&I Code 18915.
