SUBJECT: RECORDS RETENTION - ABCD 278L

REFERENCE: DSS MANUAL LETTER NO. 81-63

This is to inform you of a change in regulations, Management and Office Procedures Manual, Division 23 (Section 23-353.9), dealing with the retention period for Form ABCD 278L, "List of Authorizations to Start, Change, or Stop Aid Payments". Form ABCD 278L is a cumulative history of aid payments, FBU size, supplements, discontinuances, etc., maintained individually in each IV-A case file.

Upon request from the district attorney's office, the county welfare department will retain the ABCD 278L or equivalent document for a ten year period after case closure. Notification of the specific cases in which this record will be retained must be forwarded by the local IV-D agency to the county welfare department. Regulations previously provided only for a three year retention period. However, as a result of concerns expressed by the IV-D agencies that valuable data for the establishment and/or enforcement of child support court orders was being destroyed, the retention period has now been extended to ten years.
