SUBJECT: CASES AND RECIPIENTS NOT PAID AFDC BECAUSE THE GRANT WAS UNDER \$10

REFERENCE:

As a result of the Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act of 1981, Public Law 97-35, statutory changes were made in the Aid to Families with Dependent Children (AFDC) Program. Included in these changes was a provision requiring the states to report cases determined eligible for AFDC but whose grant was not paid because it was less than \$10.

These cases will continue to be reported in Item 8b, Other Cases, on the Aid to Families with Dependent Children - Cash Grant Caseload Movement and Expenditures Report (CA 237 FG/U). However, beginning with the July 1982 report month, cases and recipients who did not receive a payment because the amount of aid prior to any adjustments was determined to be less than \$10\$ will also be reported as a footnote on the CA 237 FG/U statistical report. The footnote will include, as separate items, both Family Group and Unemployed cases and recipients.
