SUBJECT: ALLOCATION OF PREMISE FUNDS FOR MONTHLY REPORTING/RETROSPECTIVE BUDGETING (MRRB), FY 1983/84

Attached is your FY 1983/84 state share allocation for implementation and operation of the MRRB System in the Non-Assistance Food Stamp (NAFS) Program. This supplement will be included in your January NAFS salaries and overhead allocation.

The FY 1983/84 Budget Act included \$296,000 state general fund for the MRRB premise. The methodology for distributing these funds was based on certified eligible NAFS caseload for the full 1982/83 fiscal year. Each county's share of the MRRB premise was determined by using the percent to total of individual county caseload to the statewide caseload and applying that percentage to the total MRRB funds, with a minimum allocation of \$100.
