ALL-COUNTY INFORMATION NOTICE NO. 1-105-84

TO: ALL COUNTY WELFARE DIRECTORS

SUBJECT: FOOD STAMP PROGRAM AND EARLY FRAUD DETECTION SYSTEM

During reviews of the Early Fraud Detection System, certain food stamp program operational problems are identified. The purpose of this All-County Information Notice is to carlify for counties the appropriate action to be taken in response to investigative findings.

In order to comply with Food Stamp regulations, the County Welfare Department (CWD) must proceed as follows after an investigation has been conducted:

- 1.h If the investigation finds that a PA household provided false information orh withheld information affecting its PA eligibility, the CWD shall not terminateh food stamps on that basis alone (63-301.6).h
- 2.h The household shall be given an opportunity to clarify any information relating to its food stamp eligibility or benefit level which stems from the investigation (63-300.544).h
- 3.h If the household refuses to cooperate with the CWD to resolve any discrepancies, the CWD shall terminate the household's participation for refusal to cooperate in a subsequent review of its eligibility (63-505.1).h
- 4.h If the household does cooperate with the CW# to resolve any discrepancies andh the resulting information affects the household's current eligibility or benefith level, the CWD shall take the appropriate action to reduce or terminate theh household's benefits (63-805.2).h
- 5.h Whether or not the household cooperates with the CWD, the SIU shall investigateh any household suspected of intentionally violating the Food Stamp Program regulations. During this investigation and any subsequent administrative hearingh or court proceeding on the matter, the household's participation in the program shall not be affected as long as it remains eligible for benefits (20-300.21, .22, and 63-805.2).h
