SUBJECT: GENERAL NOTICE - CATEGORICAL ELIGIBILITY

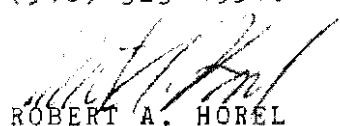
REFERENCE: ALL COUNTY LETTER NO. 87-12, DATED JANUARY 21, 1987

This will provide the County Welfare Departments (CWDs) with a copy of the English/Spanish language version of the TEMP 1695, the general notice that informs AFDC and Food Stamp recipients of the availability of retroactive food stamp benefits under the categorical eligibility provisions (M.S. 63-064.2). Notices in Chinese, Vietnamese, Cambodian, and Laotian will be mailed to all CWDs by the Languages Services Bureau when available.

Specific details of the regulation changes and the procedures for the issuance of the TEMP 1695 are outlined in Attachment 2 of All County Letter No. 87-12, dated January 21, 1987, Food Stamp Categorical Eligibility ORD #1186-54 and Treatment of Educational Loans and Grants ORD #1186-51.

CWDs that wish to alter the TEMP 1695 must submit a request to the AFDC and Food Stamp Policy Implementation Bureau, 744 P Street, Mail Station 16-31, Sacramento, CA 95814 no later than March 10, 1987.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

WELFARE MAY OWE YOU FOOD STAMPS

Because of recent changes to the food stamp rules, you may get food stamps for past months.

At any time **SINCE DECEMBER 23, 1985**

1. **WERE YOU DENIED FOOD STAMPS BECAUSE THE COUNTY SAID YOUR HOUSEHOLD HAD TOO MUCH INCOME OR RESOURCES?**

OR

2. **WERE YOUR FOOD STAMPS STOPPED BECAUSE THE COUNTY SAID YOUR HOUSEHOLD HAD TOO MUCH INCOME OR RESOURCES?**

If your answer is **YES** to Question 1 or 2 **AND EVERYONE IN YOUR HOME WAS GETTING AFDC** when your food stamps were denied or stopped, then the county may owe you food stamps.

To find out if the County does owe you food stamps, contact each county that denied you or stopped your food stamps. The county will tell you if you can get extra food stamps.
