SUBJECT: REPORTS FCI544, FCI545, and FCI546 REPLACING
PERFORMANCE STANDARDS PROJECT REPORTS

The enclosed reports FCI544, FCI545, and FCI546 are final revisions of the previous Performance Standards Project reports which ended publication in June 1987.

These reports were developed with the assistance of the Foster Care Information System (FCIS) Advisory Committee and are being produced and distributed at the request of the County Welfare Directors Association.

All reports display information in order of caseload size, from the largest to the smallest. The reports are described as follows:

1. FCI544 - CHILDREN IN FOSTER CARE DURING QUARTER

Displays cases active during the quarter, funded cases, and percentages of caseload represented by funding source, group home placements, Family Reunification, Permanent Placement and Emergency Response cases.

2. FCI545 - FOSTER CARE CASES TRANSFERRED OR TERMINATED DURING QUARTER

Displays number of transfers (intercounty and interagency), case terminations and reasons during quarter.

3. FCI546 - CHILDREN IN FOSTER CARE STATUS.....BY SUPERVISING AGENCY

Displays number of cases and percentages of County caseload for supervising agencies.
