

SUBJECT: UPCOMING REVISIONS TO THE FOOD STAMP PROGRAM MONTHLY
CASELOAD MOVEMENT STATISTICAL REPORT

The purpose of this notice is to alert all Counties of upcoming revisions to be made on the "Food Stamp Program Monthly Caseload Movement Statistical Report", DFA 296.

Federal mandate requires the State Department of Social Services (SDSS) to collect Food Stamp Program data regarding: 1) agency-caused overdue initial applications, and 2) agency-caused overdue recertifications. Currently the DFA 296 does not request data regarding untimely processing of applications. Beginning with the October 1988 report, the SDSS will be requiring all Counties to report agency-caused public assistance and non-assistance overdue action data via a revised DFA 296. Counties will receive a copy of the revised form by September 20, 1988.
