TO: ALL COUNTY WELFARE DIRECTORS

SUBJECT: AT RISK CHILD CARE PROGRAM ALLOCATIONS

Enclosed for your information is a listing of each county's initial allocation for the At Risk Child Care Program (ARCCP) for federal fiscal year 1991.

As you already know, ARCCP funds are available to employed parents who are at risk of going on or returning to Aid to Families with Dependent Children (AFDC). Since these eligible parents are not currently aided, the ARCCP funds are not directly linked to any of your programs. However, it is important to note that these new federal ARCCP funds are an additional resource for your county, thereby benefiting your programs indirectly by allowing people to continue to work in lieu of applying for and receiving aid. The ARCCP funds will be available through the existing California Department of Education (CDE) subsidized child care programs available in each county.

The ARCCP will be administered through an interagency agreement with CDE. The required 50 percent matching funds will be provided from within CDE's existing programs. The initial county allocation levels may need to be adjusted if sufficient matching funds are not available from existing CDE providers in each county. For those counties who will be unable to utilize their total allocations due to matching fund requirements, the State Department of Social Services and CDE will adjust allocations as necessary.

The allocations have been based on a "need" factor established for each county. The need factor has been determined by utilizing the following county specific information:

1) annualized AFDC family units; 2) the number of children 0-13 years of age eligible for Medi-Cal; and 3) the number of children eligible for free and reduced price school lunches. The need factor was compared to the existing subsidized child care

resources within each county, and a county share percentage was determined. Every effort has been made to provide a proportional share in county allocation levels, after existing funding available to the county was taken into account. A minimum level of funding has been specified in the amount of \$50,000 in order to ensure some level of funding for each county.

For your information, the Federal Child Care and Development Block Grant funds have been allocated in this same manner.
