The purpose of this Information Notice is to remind county welfare departments (CWDs) of the importance of providing the <u>Rutan</u> Lump Sum Informing Notice at application and at annual redetermination. The <u>Rutan</u> court order specifies that counties "shall continue to provide a written explanation of the terms of the lump sum rule to all applicants for AFDC benefits, and to all recipients at the time of annual redetermination." The <u>Rutan</u> court order additionally mandates that "Counties will be required to orally advise applicants and recipients of the importance of the notice at the time it is given, and shall document that the notice was given in the case file."

The <u>Rutan</u> order also specifies that "the county welfare departments shall not apply the rule to any AFDC recipient who received and spent the lump sum prior . . . to receiving [annual] notice. There shall be a presumption that the notice was not given if receipt of the notice is not documented in the case file . . . The foregoing presumption shall apply to each person who applied for AFDC benefits or who went through annual redetermination at any time following promulgation of regulations implementing this Consent Decree." CWDs will not apply the lump sum rule to create a period of ineligibility or collect an overpayment for a period of ineligibility unless the assistance unit's file reflects that notice as specified by the Rutan order.
