ASSISTANCE FOR NEEDY FAMILIES (TANF) TIMED-OUT CASES (AID
CODES 32 AND 3W)

REFERENCE: COUNTY FISCAL LETTERS 09/10-19 AND 09/10-42

The purpose of this erratum is to correct the retroactive effective date of the change to state-only funding for aid code 32 and 3W. In accordance with the Corrective Compliance Plan (CCP) submitted to the Administration for Children and Families, the department ceased federal claiming of these aid codes effective the September 2009 quarter (July-September). Because of the claiming changes that were made to comply with the CCP, and in order to be consistent with County Fiscal Letter (CFL) 09/10-19, aid codes 32 and 3W are state-only funded effective July 1, 2009 and no longer ticks the TANF clock as part of the federal 20 percent hardship caseload.

As instructed in CFL 09/10-19 dated September 30, 2009, counties were to begin using program codes 687 and 689 and their associated time study codes, in order for CDSS to comply with the Office of Inspector General audit findings and avoid the fiscal penalty. Counties must therefore ensure that all aid code 32 and 3W are correctly claimed using these program codes by September 30, 2010 and that any changes to the TRAC system have been properly adjusted to accurately track time on aid.
