• TO: ALL COUNTY WELFARE DIRECTORS

SUBJECT: MCGONIGLE v. STATE OF CALIFORNIA

REFERENCE:

All-County Letter No. 74-201 dated October 9, 1974 instructed you to comply with the court order in the case of McGonigle v. State of California which requires you to accept applications for retroactive benefits through December 31, 1974.

Both Los Angeles and San Diego counties experienced difficulties in sending out notices in their respective counties within the time required. These two counties have enclosed their notices with the November 15 warrants. Because of this delay in notifying potential applicants for retroactive benefits, the period during which application may be made for such retroactive benefits has been extended for residents of Los Angeles and San Diego counties to and including January 15, 1975.

Accordingly, you are instructed to accept applications for retroactive benefits from residents of Los Angeles and San Diego counties through January 15, 1975. The final date for filing applications for residents of all other counties remains December 31, 1974.
