SUBJECT: FOOD STAMP ELIGIBILITY OF HAITIAN NATIONALS IN POSSESSION

OF INS FORM 1-94S

The purpose of this letter is to advise you that as a result of the court order in the <u>Lewis vs Nelson</u> case, approximately 1780 Haitian Nationals were scheduled for release from detention camps by the end of September. Further, these Haitian Nationals are potentially eligible to participate in the Food Stamp Program, pursuant to Food Stamp Manual Section 63-403.15.

In order to identify this population, INS developed a new form, 1-94S, for issuance to all affected Haitian Nationals. The I-94S is verification of eligible alien status in accordance with Food Stamp Manual Section 63-403.321(b).

The 1-94S is a pink and white laminated card. The front contains a photo and a fingerprint along with the name, birthdate and identification number of the alien. The back of the form contains the date of parole and the expiration date which is six months from the date of issuance. Additionally, a toll-free 800 telephone number is provided for anyone with questions. For your information, a copy of this form is attached.


