TO: ALL-COUNTY WELFARE DIRECTORS

SUBJECT: FOOD STAMP WORK REGISTRATION/JOB SEARCH PROGRAM

REFERENCE: ALL-COUNTY LETTERS 82-35 AND 82-38

The purpose of this letter is to inform you of the latest development affecting the Food Stamp Work Registration/Job Search Program (WR/JS) and to advise you of what actions are now required of the counties.

On May 28, 1982, EDD Central Office released a directive to the EDD field offices requiring that as of June 1, 1982, they no longer accept food stamp work registration forms.

Because of this development, you are instructed to disregard previous All-County Letters 82-35 and 82-38. In order to ensure that food stamp applicants have the opportunity to meet the work registration requirements (see MPP Section 63-407.1), it is necessary that the counties continue to require all applicants not exempt from work registration to complete form DE 8435 FS. The completed signed form should then be placed into the case file. In the event that EDD funding is restored and the WR/JS Program becomes viable, you will be instructed to forward the completed DE 8435 FS forms to EDD.
