SUBJECT: SHORTENING THE LUMP SUM PERIOD OF INELIGIBILITY
UNDER THE DEFRA OPTIONS (ORD# 1086-48)

REFERENCE: ALL-COUNTY LETTER (ACL) NO. 86-138, DATED 12/30/86
MPP 44-207.4

ACL Number 86-138 informed you of the options available under DEFRA which the Department implemented in regulation effective January 1, 1987. One of these options includes acceptable reasons for shortening the AFDC lump sum period of ineligibility (POI). The purpose of this letter is to provide clarification and instructions for implementing this provision.

Attached are general program instructions and specific notice of action (NOA) messages. The following reproducible form and NOA messages are required:

- I. General informing notice for recipients currently in a POI (TEMP 1697).
- II. Form for requesting/certifying disposition of the lump sum (CA 41).
- III. Notices of Action (M44-207R through U).

Spanish versions of the TEMP 1697, CA 41 and NOAs are attached. Chinese, Vietnamese, Laotian and Cambodian translations will be forthcoming.
