TO: ALL COUNTY WELFARE DIRECTORS

SUBJECT: SENATE BILL 760

This is to inform you of a change this year effected by Senate Bill 760 (Chapter 1022, Statutes of 1987). The bill amended Welfare & Institutions Code (WIC) Section 11402 (d) to allow the payment of Aid to Families with Dependent Children-Foster Care (AFDC-FC) to a child placed in the home of a former nonrelated legal guardian when the guardianship has been dismissed because the child has attained age 18.

The effect of the statutory change is to allow for AFDC-FC payments to continue to wards of nonrelated legal guardians after the ward turns 18 and remains in high school or the equivalent vocational or technical training. All requirements of Eligibility and Assistance Standards Section 115-201.111 must be met for the former ward to continue to be eligible for AFDC-FC payments.
