SUBJECT: CALIFORNIA WORK OPPORTUNITY AND RESPONSIBILITY TO

KIDS (CALWORKS): INCREASE TO TEMPORARY HOMELESS

ASSISTANCE (HA) DAILY PAYMENT AMOUNTS

REFERENCE: ASSEMBLY BILL (AB) 1811 (CHAPTER 35, STATUTES OF 2018);

ACL NO. 06-25; ACL NO. 18-71; ACL NO. 18-78; MANUAL OF POLICIES AND PROCEDURES (MPP) SECTION 44-211.525

The purpose of this letter is to inform County Welfare Departments (CWDs) that effective January 1, 2019, the daily rate for temporary HA will be increasing.

### **Background/Current Law**

Temporary HA is available to homeless CalWORKs families to help pay for up to 16 consecutive days of temporary shelter, while the family is searching for permanent housing. (Note: applicants receiving AB 557 expanded HA benefits are exempt from the permanent housing search.) Current daily limits are \$65 for a family with up to four people; the fifth and each additional family member each receives \$15 a day, up to a daily maximum of \$125.

## **Change to Daily Limits**

The AB 1811 establishes that effective January 1, 2019, the daily amounts of temporary HA payments will be increased for a family with up to four members from \$65 to \$85 a day. Each additional family member will continue to get an additional \$15 a day, up to a daily maximum of \$145. This increase applies to all temporary HA, including AB 557 benefits for CalWORKs applicants fleeing domestic abuse (see <a href="ACL NO. 18-78">ACL NO. 18-78</a>) and AB 236 benefits for CalWORKs Family Reunification cases (see <a href="ACL NO. 18-71">ACL NO. 18-71</a>). All other HA provisions remain in effect.
